This program is being offered on behalf of the Central Maine Fire Chief's Association. Dan Meloche is the regional sales representative for the Rescue Alive Ice Rescue sled and is a certified Ice Rescue Instructor. The morning session will include a classroom presentation on how to manage an ice rescue event, command & control, information & communications, ice rescue equipment, hypothermia and patient handling. Dan will review real life case studies of ice rescues that have occurred in the United States. In the afternoon students will get the opportunity to use the Rescue Alive sled, the ropes and cold water suits. This will be a great program for those communities who may have to respond to an ice rescue event. It should not be limited to communities that have the Rescue Alive equipment. Communities that already have the Rescue Alive may want to send any firefighters that have not had the training direct from Dan.

Participants should bring cold water suits from their respective departments if they anticipate doing hands on evolutions. The location of the hands on will be determined at a later date.

The program will be run on December 3rd if there is ice. Alternate date will be the December 10th.
