Old Business:

Western Maine Fire Attack School:

All agreed to host WMFAS at The Bethel Inn & Conference Center. They gave us a nice package and have been very communicative and supportive of questions, meetings, etc. We have the Big Adventure Park for our Block 5 practical skill drills. They have a built in smoke machine, maze, etc. Day two of Wildland Powersaws will take place at Bethel FD. Box lunches will be provided for the offsite courses that day and are included in the registration fee.

It is not presented as certified training but appears to be interpreted that way by both FF's and Depts.
